FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

God sent his Son so that through him the world might be saved.

First Reading 2 Ch 36:14-16. 19-23

Responsorial Psalm Ps 136:1-6
Second Reading Eph 2:4-10
Gospel Jn 3:14-21



FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT: Today is known as 'Mothering Sunday'. Formerly the New Testament reading was taken from St Paul's Letter to the Galatians where he speaks about the heavenly Jerusalem as our mother. This gave rise to the Entry Antiphon with the words 'Rejoice Jerusalem' ('Laetare Jerusalem') and a focus first on our spiritual mother the Church and secondly on our human mothers. We pray in a special way for our mothers, whether living or dead, and thank God for the role they have played in giving us life not only in the body but also in the spirit, passing on their faith and values to us. The Scripture Readings in the modern Lectionary have a rather different focus. God sent his Son into the world to bring light and salvation by being raised up on the altar of the cross. If we are discouraged in the struggle to lead a Christian life we should find hope and encouragement. Through baptism Christ has given us the grace that saves us and gives us a place in heaven. What we feel as struggle is the work of God's grace transforming us into his work of art.
