

7TH SUNDAY OF EASTER: After the Lord's Ascension the disciples remained in Jerusalem gathered in prayer. He had promised to send the Holy Spirit but they did not know what form this would take or what it really meant, In the Gospel St John gives us a glimpse in Our Lord's prayer before his Passion. He has passed the Father's word on to them and sent them out into the world to bring this message of truth and love to the whole world. He consecrates himself – offers his life – so that they may accomplish this work and be consecrated in this truth. The coming of the Holy Spirit will fill them with the understanding and dedication they need. It is a gift for all time to be shared by the witness of those he has called – his Church – and not simply a personal and time-limited gift for the Twelve. This is spelt out in a concrete way in our first reading where we hear how the Apostles chose Matthias to take the place of Judas Iscariot.
