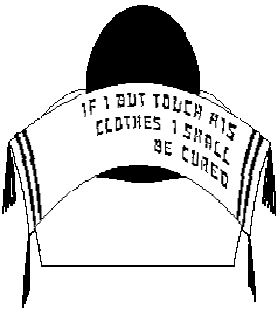

### **THIRTEENTH SUNDAY OF YEAR**

*Little girl, I tell you to get up.*

**First Reading:** Ws 1:13-15; 2:23-24

**Responsorial Psalm** Ps 29:2. 4-6. 11-13

**Second Reading:** 2 Cor 8:7. 9. 13-15

**Gospel:** Mk 5:21-43



**BIRTHDAY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST:** Today's Gospel is something of a sandwich – the story of Jesus going to restore the life of the daughter of Jairus is interrupted by that of the woman with a haemorrhage who is healed by touching Our Lord's cloak. Both are important stories in their own right but there is a common link to which the first reading alludes and which is made clear by the Responsorial Psalm. "I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me and have not let my enemies rejoice over me. O Lord, you have raised my soul from the dead, restored me to life from those who sink into the grave." The name of God, revealed to Moses, 'JHWH', comes from the verb 'to be' in Hebrew and means 'I am who am'. God is the source of all being – described in Old and New Testaments as the 'living one' or 'the one who is. The Book of Wisdom tells us he creates all things not for extinction but to exist. Life is the glory of God. This is shown not only in bringing life back to the lifeless little girl but also in bringing fullness of life to the woman who had been socially sidelined and in pain for so many years. We cannot say exactly what eternal life will be like but the Scriptures assure us that it will be life to the full – all ailments and wounds no longer a source of pain as we see in the Risen Jesus.

**YEAR OF FAITH:** Parishes across England and Wales are being sent free resources to prepare for a worldwide Catholic celebration of faith. Pope Benedict XVI will open a 'Year of Faith' on 11th October 2012, which will end on the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King, on 24th November 2013. The start of the Year coincides with three significant events in the life of the Catholic Church: 50th anniversary of the Second Vatican Council, 20th anniversary of the publication of the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the Synod of Bishops in Rome focusing on evangelisation. The Department for Evangelisation and Catechesis will coordinate resourcing the Year in England and Wales. Bishop Kieran Conry, Department Chair, said: *'The Year provides a wonderful opportunity for the Catholic community in England and Wales to be renewed in, to celebrate and share the joy of its faith in Jesus Christ. The Pope writes: "Faith grows when it is lived as an experience of love received and when it is communicated as an experience of grace and joy." Porta Fidei, 7th May this be our shared experience as we prepare for the Year and may our combined efforts serve fruitfully the mission of the Church.'* Every parish in England and Wales will receive five booklets, which are aimed at parish priests, catechists and/or parish councils, to support their preparations. The booklets propose a number of key themes and highlight resources and initiatives that will be offered in support of catechesis and evangelisation.
