### ***CORPUS CHRISTI***

*They all ate as much as they wanted.*

First Reading: Gen 14:18-20  
Responsorial Psalm Ps 109:1-4  
Second Reading: 1 Cor 11:23-26  
Gospel: Lk 9:11-17



**CORPUS CHRISTI:** “The Eucharist is the food reserved for those who in Baptism were delivered from slavery and have become sons; it is the food that sustained them in the long journey of the Exodus through the desert of human existence. Like the manna for the people of Israel, for every Christian generation the Eucharist is the indispensable nourishment that sustains them as they cross the desert of this world, parched by the ideological and economic systems that do not promote life but rather humiliate it. It is a world where the logic of power and possession prevails rather than that of service and love; a world where the culture of violence and death is frequently triumphant. Yet Jesus comes to meet us and imbues us with certainty: he himself is the ‘Bread of Life’. He repeated this to us in the words of the Gospel Acclamation: ‘I am the living bread from Heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever.’” Pope Benedict XVI. The Eucharist is the focus of many of the remaining events scheduled for the Year of Faith. Pope Francis invites us all to unite with him spiritually during the Procession of the Blessed this afternoon in Rome – 4.00-5.00 p.m. UK time. Our own Procession takes place at the end of 11.00 a.m. Mass today concluding with benediction at about 12.25 p.m. If you are unable to stay on for this, please remain in place until the Procession leaves the Church. If the weather is inclement there will just be a short Procession within the Church closing with Benediction at about 12.10 p.m.

**FOOD BANK SCHEME:** A new hard-hitting report from Church Action on Poverty and Oxfam is warning of Britain's 'hidden hungry', and highlighting the scandal of food poverty in 21st-century Britain. The Trussell Trust, which is the biggest provider of food banks in the UK, had last month reported that more than 350,000 people turned to their food banks for help in the last year, almost triple the number who received food aid in the previous year. However, this new report is warning that the actual figure receiving food aid could be more than half a million people, as there are many non-Trussell food banks, and hunger is not being monitored properly by the Government. Government agencies must record and monitor people experiencing food poverty in the UK in order to establish more accurate numbers. Church Action on Poverty invites anyone concerned about this to visit [www.church-poverty.org.uk/foodfuelfinance](http://www.church-poverty.org.uk/foodfuelfinance). The report is freely available to download, and a simple e-action will allow you to send a message to your MP in support of the call for a Parliamentary Inquiry. Churches Together in Coggeshall have agreed to support the local scheme organised by the Trussell Trust in Braintree and all three Churches will have a box in place where you can contribute items for distribution to those in need. A list of the items wanted is available for your guidance. They do not want time expired or unsuitable produce. The Churches in Kelvedon and Feering will also be cooperating with this scheme and a box will be left in St Dominic's room. The nearest centre for Tiptree is Colchester and the Churches in Tiptree are investigating the possibilities.
