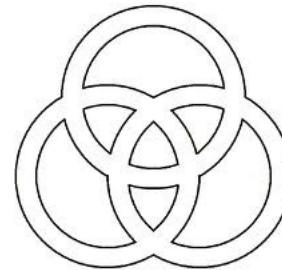

**THE MOST HOLY TRINITY:** “Today we contemplate the Most Holy Trinity as Jesus introduced us to it. He revealed to us that God is love “not in the oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance” (Preface). He is the Creator and merciful Father; he is the Only-Begotten Son, eternal Wisdom incarnate, who died and rose for us; he is the Holy Spirit who moves all things, cosmos and history, toward their final, full recapitulation. Three Persons who are one God because the Father is love, the Son is love, the Spirit is love. God is wholly and only love, the purest, infinite and eternal love. He does not live in splendid solitude but rather is an inexhaustible source of life that is ceaselessly given and communicated.” Pope Benedict XVI.

**DIAMOND JUBILEE OF H.M. QUEEN ELIZABETH II:** This weekend the nation celebrates the Queen’s Diamond Jubilee. By direction of the Bishops every parish will offer the principal Mass in thanksgiving. It will incorporate a different first reading appropriate to the celebration, even though it is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. There will be special bidding prayers, an additional prayer for the Queen to be said before the final blessing – the one that used to be sung at the end of the main Mass every Sunday, ‘Domine, salvam fac reginam nostram Elisabeth...’ – and the singing of the first and third verses of the National Anthem. In addition to other secular celebrations there will be an **Ecumenical Service** for Kelvedon and Feering at All Saints, Feering this Sunday afternoon at 4.00 p.m. – an opportunity for the whole local Christian community to give thanks together. In Tiptree there will be a civic service the **next Sunday** 10<sup>th</sup> June 4.00 p.m. at St Luke’s.

**CHAIN OF PRAYER:** We call upon our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ to join the Knights of St Columba in this ‘Chain of Prayer’. We will be praying that our politicians heed the message of faith, to uphold human life from conception to the grave and defend the sanctity of marriage between a man and a woman. Our campaign will consist of each local Council of the Order, where possible, organising or joining the congregation of a local parish in celebrating at least one Mass for the above intention during the period from the feast of St Columba (9th June) until the opening Mass of our Supreme Council in October. It will be launched at three separate venues across Britain on the weekend of the Feast of St Columba. **Friday 8th June** in St Columbas Church Glasgow 7.30pm Celebrated by Archbishop Conti. **Saturday 9th June**, Cardiff Cathedral and **Sunday 10th June** Aylesford Priory, Kent. We will also have a number of other milestones during the summer as major links in the prayer chain. A Prayer Vigil at Westminster is being organised for late Summer, Marriage Sunday on 26th August in Scotland, the Scottish KSC Pilgrimage on 16th September at Carfin, the KSC Deceased Members Mass in the Cathedral in Liverpool on 6th October and the Supreme Council of the Order in Glasgow on 26th October. This is an Opportunity to Serve in Catholic Action.
