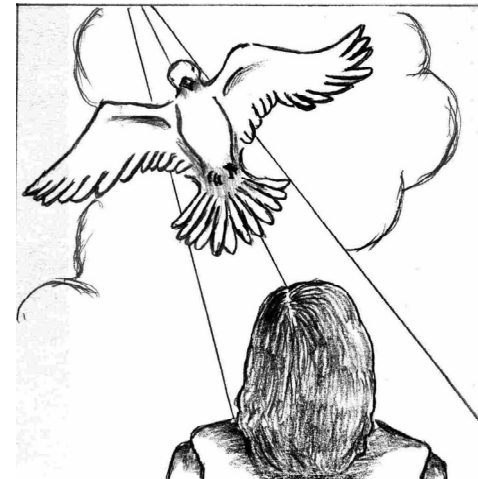

The Baptism of the Lord

While Jesus after his own baptism was at prayer, heaven opened.

First Reading	Is 40:1-5.9-11
Responsorial Psalm	Ps 103:1-4.24-25.27-30
Second Reading	Tt 2:11-14.3:4-7
Gospel	Lk 3:15-16.21-22

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD: This feast marks the transition from our Lord's infancy and hidden life into his public ministry. This is marked liturgically by the beginning of 'Ordinary Time', or Sundays 'through the year'. After John has baptised Our Lord the Heavenly Father reveals Jesus to be his beloved Son by the outward manifestation of the descent of the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove and the voice speaking from heaven. The Feast itself is of recent origin (1962) but for many centuries the Epiphany, or showing, of the Lord was seen as including not just the Magi, but also the Baptism of Christ and his first sign – the Wedding at Cana, and this wider view was the focus on the Octave Day of the Epiphany. 'Ordinary' is a rather unfortunate way to designate the wonders of Our Lord's public life! Each Sunday we hear the wonders of his teaching and miracles unfolded – this year by St Luke.
