## Ascension of the Lord

*As he blessed them he was carried up to heaven.*

**ASCENSION OF THE LORD:** Today we keep the transferred Feast of the Ascension. This is a mystery of Our Lord's definitive taking leave of his earthly life among us to reign at the right hand of the Heavenly Father. The Anglican Shrine Chapel at Walsingham represents this at the side altar of the Ascension by the soles of his feet disappearing into cloud. No human artistic representation, nor even the words of Scripture, can adequately convey what the disciples experienced. It was an event similar to that experienced by Peter, James and John on Mount Tabor. The angels encourage them not to strain their eyes on the heavens. In the fullness of time he will return in glory on the clouds of heaven. For now they must prepare for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will not be a poor substitute for the visible presence of the Lord but an empowering and powerful presence that will transform their lives. Today, then, we honour the Kingship of Christ manifested by the Ascension, but we also await in joyful expectation at this prelude to the coming of the Holy Spirit.

**ECUMENICAL NEWS:** We join in prayer with our friends at Christchurch, Coggeshall, who today celebrate the Tercentenary of their church, and also at the Anglican churches in Tolleshunt D'Arcy, Tolleshunt Major, Tollesbury and Salcott who welcome their new minister tomorrow. The monthly prayer breakfast in Coggeshall takes place a week early (22<sup>nd</sup> May) because of the bank holiday. If you would like to go, please sign on list in the porch.

**PAPAL VISIT - collection in parishes:** On 23<sup>rd</sup> May there will be prayers and a special collection in all parishes in Scotland, England and Wales for the Papal Visit. Prayer cards for the Visit are being distributed to all parishioners attending Mass on Pentecost Sunday. Collections will be held to assist in meeting the costs of the Visit payable by the Church, which are currently estimated to be at least £7m. Over £3m has already been raised towards this total. Archbishop Vincent Nichols, President of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, said "I would urge everyone in the Catholic community to pray for this Visit and to support the collection for it as generously as they can. The Holy Father's Visit is a wonderful opportunity for the gentle light of faith to be contemplated afresh by everyone. He will confirm the strong faith of our own community. But my prayer, too, is that the Visit will serve to kindle a new spiritual vitality, a questioning of the heart for many in our society who may have no religious affiliation but who are in some way seeking a deeper meaning and purpose to their lives." The costs associated with the state aspects of the Visit will be paid by the government. The costs payable by the church consist mainly in the organising costs of three major public pastoral gatherings – in Scotland, London and the West Midlands. In our Diocese each parish has been assessed. Our contribution has been set at **£441.31**. Special envelopes should be available this weekend.
