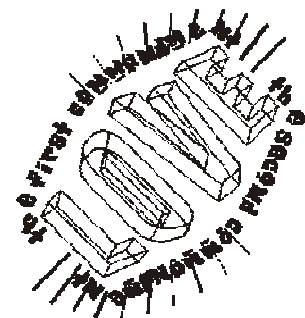

**30TH SUNDAY:** Today's readings invite us to grow in understanding of the Church's teaching on social justice. Justice is more than simply fulfilling contracts or obligations at a personal level. It is about a social structure that provides for the needs of the stranger, or exile, the widow and orphan, and regulates loans so that they do not oppress the poor. It is a message just as much for today's complex society as the simpler society of Moses' time. Human nature does not change. A recent news story from China about how passers by ignored the plight of a two-year old who had been run over reminds us that callousness is part of every age and so is the temptation to put our own interests first.

**NEW MASS TRANSLATION: Domine non sum dignus. Lord, I am not worthy.** One of the strengths of the new translation of the Roman Missal is the way it better reveals to us the scriptural and patristic source of many of our prayers. The new translation should help us become more aware of how the prayers we say today have their origin in the inspired words of scripture, and in the well tested expressions of the teachers of the faith who have preceded us. This prayer which we use in its new translation today has its origins in the words of a pagan soldier, who implored Jesus to heal his servant. This man was held in the greatest respect by the Jews but he held himself in great humility before the Lord. There is no false modesty or politesse in his words, which now become ours. Rather, they express profound respect for the one who alone is our Saviour and Lord. The spirit of reverence and awe that comes to expression here is a spirit that should characterise the whole of the Communion rite.
