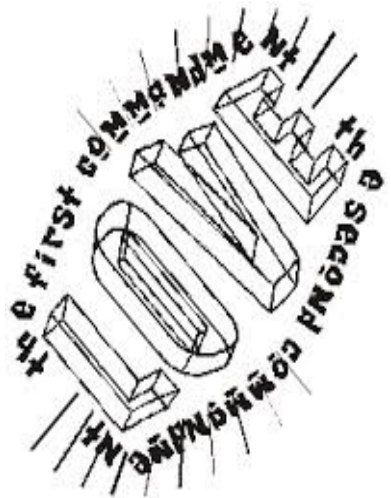

THIRTIETH SUNDAY OF YEAR

You must love the Lord your God and your neighbour as yourself.

First Reading:	Ex 22:20-26
Responsorial Psalm	Ps 17:2-4.47.51
Second Reading:	1 Th 1:1-5-10
Gospel:	Mt 22:34-40



THIRTIETH SUNDAY: There is a saying 'Charity begins at home'. There is some truth in this. Charity means love not simply giving material aid. It should start in the home but not end there! It should spread out to embrace our neighbour and this is the question today's readings ask of us. The whole Law and Prophets hang on the two great commandments, to love God and to love our neighbour as ourselves. In our first reading God tells Moses that this does not imply restricting our help or the demands of justice only to those who are close to us. "You must not molest the stranger or oppress him, for you lived as strangers in the land of Egypt." What does this imply for us about those who come to our country whether as refugees or asylum seekers or as economic migrants?
