**26<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF YEAR:** Today's Gospel is third of three lengthy parables that speak to us in different ways of the importance of using God's material blessings wisely. Two weeks ago we heard how the Prodigal Son wasted his assets. Last week the unjust steward was praised for his astuteness in turning things to his advantage. Today we hear the story of the rich man ('Dives' in Latin) and Lazarus. The rich man had no excuse for ignoring Lazarus. Not only was he wealthy, he had to pass Lazarus every day. He could not claim to be unaware of his needs. They just did not impinge on his conscience. He did not abuse Lazarus or treat him badly. It was a sin of omission. The parable reminds us that what we do not do is as much a choice as what we do. Are there areas of neglect in our lives? Today let us stop to think who may suffer as a result of our negligence. At least we have a chance to start making amends. There will be no personal warning from the Lord – he has already spoken to us through the Scriptures.

**ADMISSIONS – PRIEST'S REFERENCE FORM:** If you wish to apply for a place in a Catholic school for September 2011, you need to obtain a copy of the above form which is being distributed through the Catholic schools. Alternatively you can find the form on the Diocesan Website under "schools". The Diocese offers the following advice:

1. You can download the Priests' Reference form directly. You need to fill in **one copy** of Part A and take it to the appropriate Priest (preferably the Parish Priest of the Church where you regularly attend Mass).
2. With this Part A you need to have **as many copies of part B as the number of schools to which you are applying. You need to write the name of the school to which you are applying on the back of each Part B. For example, if you are applying to 3 Catholic schools, you need to give 3 copies of part B to the Priest. You must write on the back of each copy of Part B the name of one of the schools. The Priest will then send the Part B copies to the relevant schools.**
3. You should also give to the Priest a list of all the Catholic schools to which you are applying.
