13TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: One of the challenges of flying Ryanair is to travel light, knowing that you will be charged extra for a fairly limited amount of baggage placed in the hold. It is relatively easy for a priest to travel light – he doesn't need too many changes of clothes. For others it is more difficult and some seem to carry their whole wardrobe with them. Both our first reading and Gospel invite us to ask ourselves whether we travel light – not in the literal sense, but in the sense that our many commitments make it hard for us to go where the Spirit leads. Family bonds are surely to be prized and not lightly disregarded but there is a point where fledglings need to leave the nest and taking that step can be frightening. Our Lord tells us that there is a higher value than even family relationships and that is our relationship with God. Today we have our annual Mission Appeal given by a member of the Comboni Missionary Order or 'Verona Fathers'. Like all missionaries down the centuries, including St Augustine and St Patrick, they are called to take the Lord's call in a more literal way than most of us. Today we pray for their work and ask God's blessing upon it.
