STS PETER & PAUL

*You are Peter, and I will give you the keys
of the kingdom of heaven.*

First Reading: Acts 12:1-11
Responsorial Psalm Ps 33:2-9
Second Reading: 2 Tm 4:6-8. 17-18
Gospel: M 16:13-19



STS PETER & PAUL: Today we honour the Apostles Saints Peter and Paul. Apart from their many other achievements they were jointly responsible for building the community of the Church in Rome and each are honoured with a great basilica on the sites of their burial. Many years ago archaeologists discovered under the Vatican a Second Century monument known as the 'trophy' of St Peter and nearby remains of a First Century burial, almost certainly the bones of St Peter. In recent years fresh investigations beneath St Paul outside the Walls discovered remains believed to be those of St Paul. Both experienced persecution and imprisonment. The deliverance of St Peter from his chains, described in our first reading, is depicted in one of the windows at Kelvedon. Throughout it all the power of God sustained and strengthened them until the time came for them to shed their blood as a final act of witness. Today, as we honour Saint Peter and Saint Paul and thank God for what they did for Holy Church in their day, let us commend to their intercession in heaven with great affection and devotion the life and ministry of our Holy Father Pope Francis.
