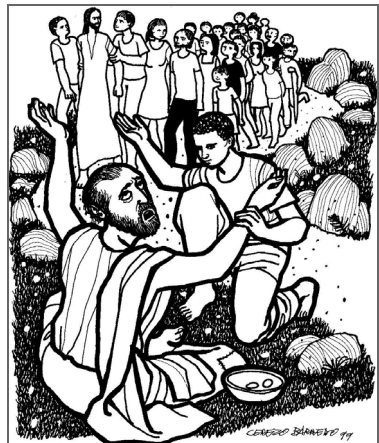

THIRTIETH SUNDAY OF YEAR

Master, let me see again

First Reading: Jer 31:7-9
Responsorial Psalm Ps 125.R.3
Second Reading: Heb 5:1-6
Gospel: Mark 10:46-52



30TH SUNDAY OF YEAR: The Prophet Jeremiah is a byword for ‘doom and gloom’ – giving us the descriptive word ‘Jeremiad’ – but today his message is one of hope and joy. God’s ultimate purpose is the in-gathering of his people. Those who went into exile in tears will return in joy. No doubt Jeremiah’s attention was focussed on the short term at a time when the Babylonians had captured Jerusalem, but as God’s voice he also points to a purpose that will be completed only at the end of time and in a heavenly rather than earthly Jerusalem. This hope is given liturgical expression this week in the Feast of All Saints and Commemoration of All Souls. We give thanks to God for all those who have already found their way into God’s company in the heavenly Jerusalem and pray for those on their journey, passing through the cleansing waters of the Jordan, being made ready for their heavenly home by the purifying fire of God’s love in Purgatory. All Saints is a Holy Day of Obligation with Mass at the usual times: Kelvedon 10.00 a.m.; Coggeshall 6.00 p.m.; Tiptree 7.30 p.m. On All Souls Day there will be the usual three Masses but at the following times: Kelvedon 9.00 a.m.; Coggeshall 10.00 a.m.; Tiptree 12.00 noon.

NOVEMBER: MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS: You can obtain a plenary indulgence for the Holy Souls under the usual conditions on All Souls Day, by visiting a church or cemetery and praying the Our Father, Hail Mary and Apostles’ Creed for the intentions of the Holy Father. There are also many other indulgenced prayers and devotions for the month of November. Please leave the names of those you would like to be prayed for in the containers by the altar. Mass requests should be handed in an envelope in the usual way.

AENNE WERNER-LEGGETT, BEING MARY? : Irish Catholic Immigrant Women and Home and Community Building in Harold Hill, Essex, 1947-1970 (Eleven International Publishing, The Hague, 2012 ISBN 978-94-90947-76-7, pp. xi + 283). This is a new publication of an historical-sociological study of the role of Irish Women on the London overspill estate at Harold Hill, Romford, Essex, in the post-war period. It draws upon material in the Brentwood Diocesan Archives, the Archives of St Edward's Catholic Church, Romford, and the Archives of the Brentwood Ursuline Sisters, as well as personal interviews. It chronicles the foundation out of St Edward, Romford, of the two Catholic parishes in Harold Hill, viz. Most Holy Redeemer by Father Brian Foley (later Bishop of Lancaster) in 1952 and St Dominic by Father (later Monsignor Canon) Michael McKenna in 1954. It also charts the development of St Ursula's Catholic Primary School which was established by the Brentwood Ursulines.
