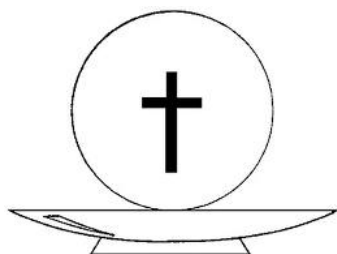

ST PETER AND ST PAUL

*You are Peter, and I will give you the keys
of the kingdom of heaven.*

First Reading: Acts 12:1-11

ST PETER & ST PAUL: Today we honour the Apostles Saints Peter and Paul. Apart from their many other achievements they were jointly responsible for building the community of the Church in Rome and each are honoured with a great basilica on the sites of their burial. Many years ago archaeologists discovered under the Vatican a Second Century monument known as the 'trophy' of St Peter and nearby remains of a First Century burial, almost certainly the bones of St Peter. Within the last couple of years fresh investigations beneath St Paul outside the Walls discovered remains believed to be those of St Paul. Today, as we honour Saint Peter and Saint Paul and thank God for what they did for Holy Church in their day, let us commend to their intercession in heaven with great affection and devotion the life and ministry of our Holy Father Pope Francis.
