
*Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty*

**5<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER:** “I am the true vine.” Jesus goes on to say that we are the branches. A branch can be cut off from the vine but the word ‘vine’ refers to the whole plant including the branches, not just to the trunk or stock. Our life and the life of Christ cannot be separated without us dying. We depend on him for the lifeblood of grace to flow through our veins. Whatever we do in union with Christ is his work as well as ours. This is why he promises that if we remain in him our prayers will be answered. Sometimes, though, what we ask for from the best of intentions, or the choices we make are not in harmony with his will or for our own good. These are weak or straggling branches that perhaps rub against another or prevent the light getting to it. Our heavenly Father, the vinedresser, does not cut us off completely but he does prune us to produce more vigorous and fruitful growth. When prayer seems not to be granted, or a path we have chosen is frustrated, we should not give up but it may be that God wants us to look in a different direction.

**GIFT AID FOR EASYFUNDRAISING:** If you are currently supporting our parish through Easyfundraising, please note that we can now claim Gift Aid on donations raised. Kindly update your Account Setting to activate Gift Aid and enable claims moving forward. Gift Aid is operated by the Government and allows charities to claim the basic rate of tax on every pound donated. This means that if you're a UK tax payer, every £1 you raise with easyfundraising is actually worth £1.25 for your cause. If you are a UK taxpayer, you can help St Mary Immaculate & The Holy Archangels Catholic Church (Coggeshall, Kelvedon & Tiptree) claim 25% extra on each donation via Gift Aid - at no extra cost. If you are a Higher rate taxpayer, you can reclaim relieve for Higher rate tax for your tax return.
